

Slippery Rock Municipal Authority held a committee meeting on Wednesday, June 24, 2026, at the Slippery Rock Municipal Authority Office, 116 Crestview Road, Slippery Rock, PA.

Present at the Authority Office were Paul Dickey, Tom McPherson, Matt Kovacik, Josh Miller, and Heather Sholes.

Chairman, Dickey called the Committee Meeting to order at 6:07 p.m.

Kovacik moved to hire Andrew Fornadley before the next scheduled regular board meeting, at the operator rate or less, if employment seems appropriate. McPherson seconded, and the motion passed.

Sholes reported that the 2025 Financial Audit was finished and is due by the DCED by June 30th. Kovacik moved to approve Resolution 2026-07; Resolution to accept the financial statements and annual independent audit report, for the Authority's 2025 fiscal year, and to authorize the chairman to execute a representation letter. McPherson seconded, and the motion passed.

General Manager Miller updated on the Elm Street Waterline Replacement Project, stating that the equipment is lined up. The excavator will be rented starting July 8th. This gives the Authority 2 days to cut the road. The plan is to have Elm Street closed from West Cooper to Gateway Park, local traffic only.

Continuing, Miller updated on 656 New Castle Road, Metalico Slippery Rock, stating that the new owners would like to tap and connect into the SRMA's system via a line extension.

Additional business, Kovacik inquired about 565 Slippery Rock Road. Sholes informed that the check had been cut and was waiting on Mr. Campbell to sign the release.

With no further business, at 6:18 p.m., Kovacik moved to adjourn, McPherson seconded, and the motion carried.
